## **Smoke Alarm Legislation Under The Ontario Fire Code** **Effective March 1, 2006**

Every home in Ontario must have a working smoke alarm on every storey and outside all sleeping areas.  
IT'S THE L A W.

Homeowners and landlords are responsible for supplying and installing alarms.

## **New Carbon Monoxide Alarm Legislation Under The Ontario Fire Code** **Effective January 1, 2014**

New fire code amendments now make it mandatory to have a carbon monoxide alarms in every residential building that have fossil fuel as their heating source and or an attached garage to the building.

Fossil fuels would consist of natural gas, oil, propane or wood.

Carbon Monoxide alarms should be installed by the manufacturer's recommendation near the bedroom area.

Homeowners and landlords are responsible for supplying and installing alarms.
